

**2009 Main Street Farmer's Market**  
**EVERY SATURDAY FROM 8am – 11am**  
**July through September**  
**5<sup>th</sup> & Main Street in Guymon**

**Objective:**

The Main Street Farmer's Market was created specifically to provide local producers across the Panhandle Region the opportunity to sell directly to consumers and to bring people together in the heart of the community to build relationships that enrich our lives throughout the year.

**Guidelines:**

1. All producers shall register with the Main Street Guymon office located at 116 NE 5<sup>th</sup> Street or the Business Enterprise Center at 802 NE 6<sup>th</sup> Street. No fee shall be charged.
2. No one shall set up earlier than 7:00am. Vendors will be assigned a space upon the completion of their registration sheet. Assigned location shall be for the entire 2009 season. Unused assigned spaces will be released at 8:00 am.
3. Vendors are assigned a designated space and may **only** set up in those boundaries.
4. Whole shell eggs offered **must** be from animals raised by grower. No purchased eggs may be sold. (State Health Department regulations)
5. Processed / canned foods being sold for profit **must** be prepared in a state licensed kitchen. (State Health regulations)
6. Vendors shall limit their offerings to produce, food, or food products. No crafts will be allowed in keeping with the idea of a Farmer's Market, unless they are derived from a garden item. Any items in doubt will be approved by the Main Street board prior to being offered for sale. If there is significant interest in selling crafts, then a separate craft market will be considered.
7. Final decision on compliance shall rest with City of Guymon, Main Street Guymon, and Texas County Health Department.
8. Vendors refusing to comply with above regulations will not be allowed to participate in future markets or may be asked to leave immediately.
9. Vendors will be required to have their own cash box and responsible for collecting and submitting their sales tax.
