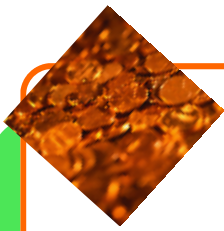

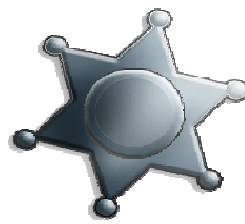

Our goal is to ensure that Guymon will continue to be an enjoyable community in which to live, work, visit, dine, and shop.

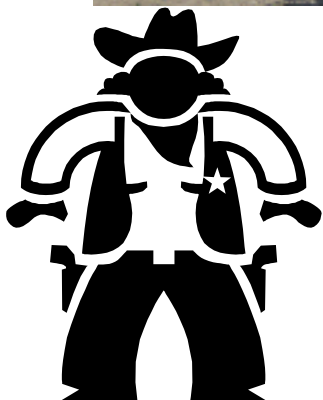
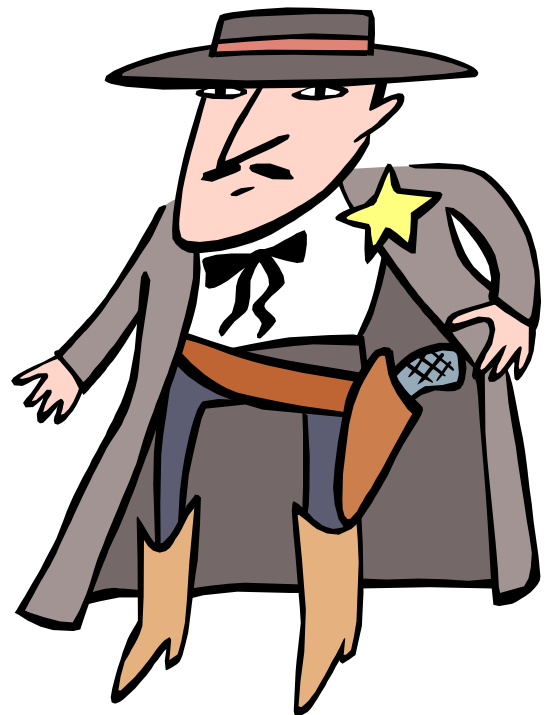


**Pioneer Days is rapidly approaching and Main Street Guymon will be out during the week of the celebrations looking for “Dress Western Week” offenders!**
