**And I answered, "How?"**

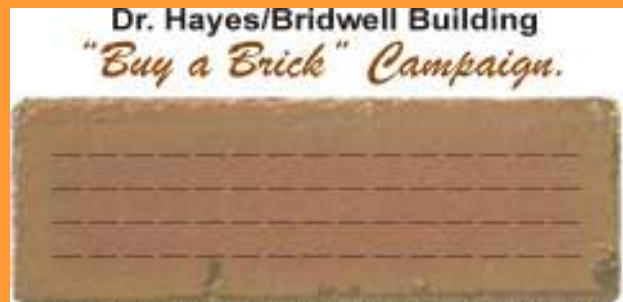
**The world is such a vast place
