Guymon Receives TEA 21 Grant For Streetscape Project

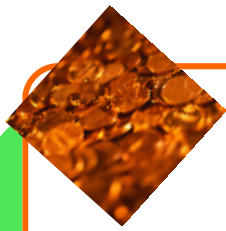
Guymon has been awarded a Highway Beautification Grant from the OK Department of Transportation in the amount of \$400K. There is also an additional \$100K matching grant from the Nash Foundation to apply towards this project as well. This project is to be used on Main Street between Highway 54 and 4th Street. This has been a two year endeavor to increase the visibility of our downtown business district and pull travelers off the highway, by beautifying the south entrance of Main Street.

There has been much controversy surrounding a median aspect of this project. However the dollars are spent, improvements to our Main Street, both functionally and aesthetically, are very welcoming; and the potential impact on the business in this district as well as our community are very positive aspects to consider. Over the upcoming months, Main Street Guymon and the City of Guymon will be working diligently to come to a compromise that will benefit all of our businesses needs. We want downtown Guymon to be somewhere we all want to be!
