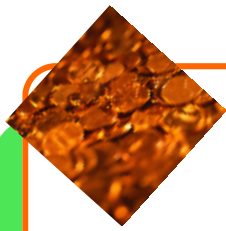
Bricks offers that and much more. Come by The Bricks at 122 NW 4th Street and experience something new that'll have you wishing you could stay a while... then do!

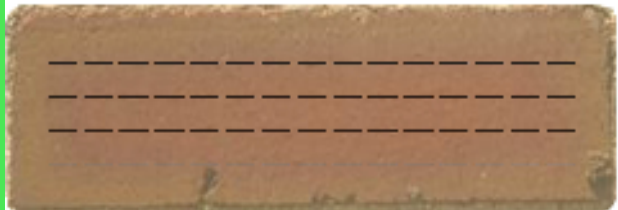
