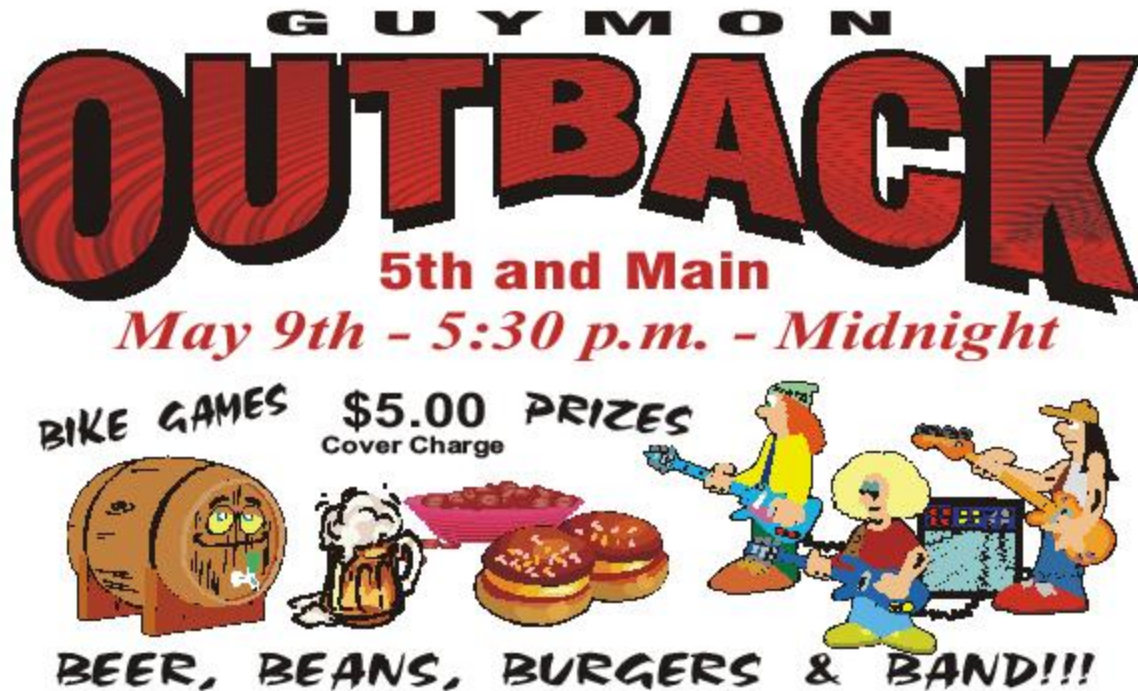

You are invited to the Third Annual Meeting of the membership of Main Street Guymon, which will be held on April 15, 2008. The purpose of the meeting shall be to announce the Board of Directors of Main Street Guymon for the coming year and to hold an annual meeting for updates and awards.

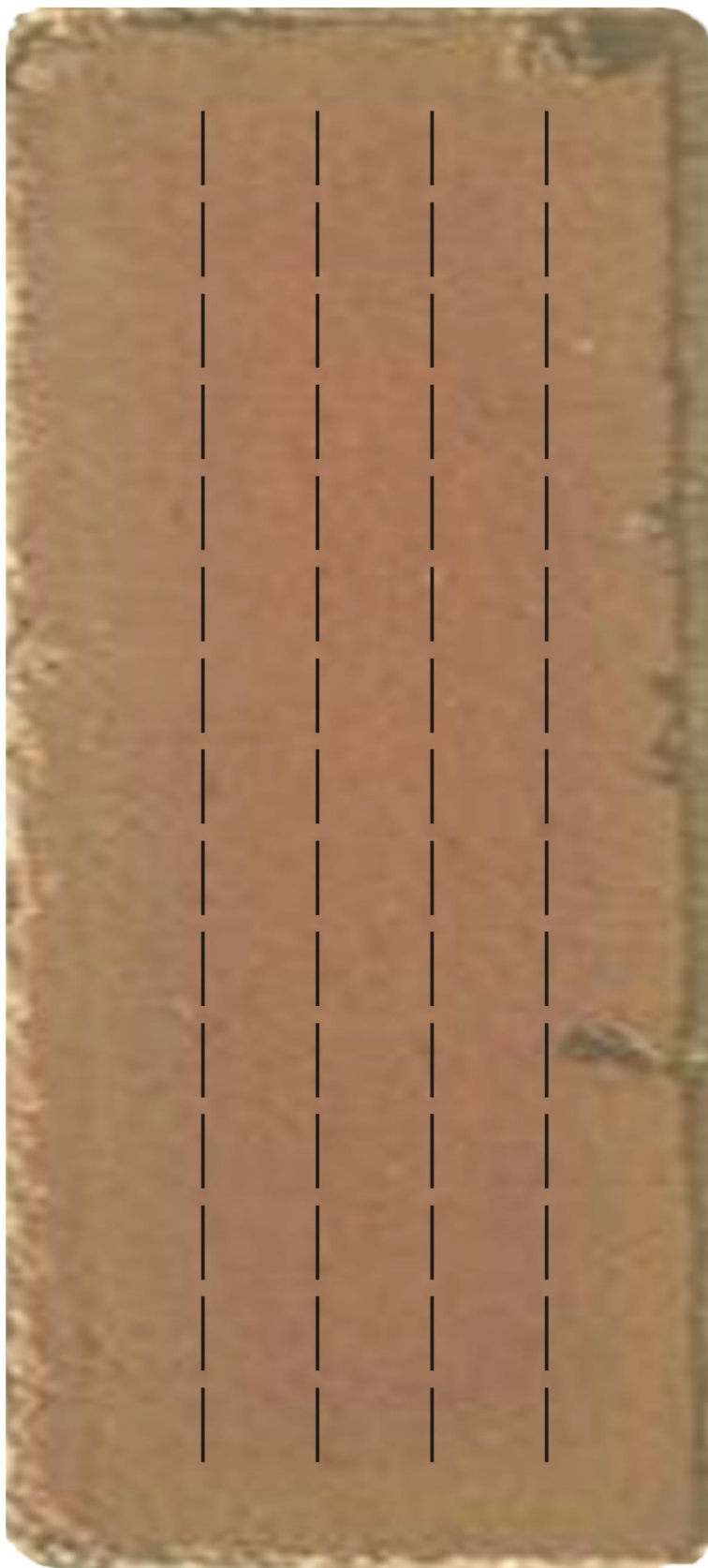
*The annual meeting will be held on April 15, 2008. at the renovated Main Street Guymon Office at 116 NE 5<sup>th</sup> Street. This will begin at 6:15 pm. with a board meeting at 7:15 pm. Please make plans to attend, your input is valued!*

The by-laws stipulate that directors shall be elected by the membership by mailed ballot and the new directors will be announced at the annual meeting. Every member shall have one vote for each available Director's position—there will be four positions available for this election. Nominations to the ballot slate can be made either: (1) by petition submitted to the MSG office more than 20 days in advance of the annual meeting, signed by nine members; or (2) by the nominating committee, which shall consist of the outgoing Board members and the Chairman.
