Old Business: It was moved and seconded to accept the following changes to the Main Street Guymon By-Laws.

ARTICLE I change the last sentence to read "nonprofit corporation and *maintain* exemption..."

ARTICLE VII, Annual Meeting, change the annual meeting to the third Tuesday in February.

- ARTICLE VII, Directors: change to read that the Director hires support personnel upon the approval of the board for the position.
- ARTICLE VII, Elections: Notify of the election on website and facebook. The voting is at the meeting, but absentee ballots are available.
- ARTICLE VII, Vacancies: Change the last sentence to "Three consecutive absences from regular Board of Director's meetings shall be considered a vacancy." Add "A proxy who represents the same business can be designated by the board member to serve as a proxy."

BOARD TERMS, add limited to two full consecutive terms, with one year ...
