Design Committee – Purchased four trash receptacles that the City of Guymon will place on each corner of 5<sup>th</sup> & Main. Prices for both benches and trash receptacles have increased by \$100 but this is still a good value compared to other options. Benches for members are now \$490 and it is slightly more for nonmembers. Each board member is challenged to sell one brick this month for \$100. This is a great fundraiser because the only costs are engraving.

**Promotions Committee** – Outback is May 11, all board members are invited to attend and help. **Business Committee** – Welcome buckets will be given to new downtown businesses as a recruitment effort. Five will be given out this month.

Windows – Tom Davis has replaced the front windows and is doing some painting.
